

## **How is our school accessible to children with SEND?**

### **How accessible is the school environment?**

Trinity school is fully wheelchair accessible with accessible parking spaces provided close to the entrance. We have three toilets that are wheelchair accessible and two of which have a full wet room shower facility and ability to be made into a medical room. There is access to the second floor using the lift and as we are a recently built school all our corridors are wide allowing easy access. All rooms and entrances are accessible for all and we have experience of enabling children with physical difficulties to be able to make the most of our school environment.

### **How accessible is your information?**

Information is available on the school website and parents are emailed and sent texts about important information in addition to regular newsletters. Our office staff, Kay, are available to answer any questions face to face. If there was a specific need to aid a parent in getting information then we would seek out the necessary support/help.

### **How accessible is the provision?**

If your child requires something in addition to enable them to access learning we will endeavour to provide that support or equipment where necessary , such as sloped writing tables, coloured overlays, supported seating, pencil grips, recording equipment etc.

The school has a range of ICT programmes for pupils with SEN in addition to IPADs, headphones, computers and keyboards as well as interactive whiteboards installed in every classroom.

We use widget throughout school both on laptops and ipads to enable communication and have a wide range of applications to support and extend learning wherever necessary, i.e. keyboards for the ipads, applications to record and play back ideas or to turn text into spoken language etc.
