

Who are the people providing services to children with SEND in school?

School provision

- Teachers responsible for teaching SEN groups/individuals.
- Teaching Assistants and HLTAs mainly working either in class or in the group rooms with either individual children or small groups.
- ICT support for both ipads, netbooks and PCs in the form of writing and maths programmes: clicker, clicker sentences, word shark, number shark, various phonic programmes, recording apps, widget etc. which is delivered according to need. Extra equipment is available, such as keyboards for ipads and ipads for intervention work.
- A learning mentor offers intervention and support for both learning and emotional and social difficulties, either on a regular basis or as and when it is required.
- Teaching Assistants or HLTAs offering support for children with emotional and social development.
- Assorted assessments are available within school where possible.
