Number

Please help your child to work towards achieving this statement:

I can read and write numbers 1-30 as a number.

Make your own number cards being carefully to write all your numbers correctly. Then can you practise your counting and order your cards? Can you sort your cards into odd and even numbers? Challenge: Can you write some of these numbers in words?

RE

This half term we are learning about being thankful at Harvest time. Can you think about what you are thankful for in your life?

Harvest takes place in the season of Autumn. Can you look for signs of Autumn around Buckshaw Village and bring what you find (eg conkers, acorns, and pinecones) into school?

Our Learning This Half Term:

English

We shall be reading stories written by Oliver Jeffers and thinking about how the characters in these stories are feeling. We shall be writing about our favourite part of a story, remembering to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
